R1. Keith Cronin (IRL) / Marshall Clarke (GBR) (Citroen DS3 R3T)
Pulled the rear of bumper off. It's a bit greasy and it just stepped out on me.

R4. Elfyn Evans (GBR) / Philip Pugh (GBR) (Ford Fiesta R2)
I think we have the right tyres with cut slicks.

R8. Desi Henry (GBR) / Barry McNulty (GBR) (Citroen DS3 R3)
Massive spin! We got stuck and dropped a load of time.

R10. Osian Pryce (GBR) / Iestyn Williams (GBR) (Citroen DS3 R3)
Wrong tyres on rear, maybe I'm too cautious.

R2. Tom Cave (GBR) / Craig Parry (GBR) (Citroen DS3 R3)
Steady run on inters. We think it's wet on the next stage.

R6. Guy Wilks (GBR) / David Moynihan (IRL) (Renault Twingo R2 Evo)
All tricky. Brakes are fixed and we took a safe choice on tyres.
